Rules and Regulations

- Registration is open to ballet students of all nationalities and genders, aged 5 to 28.
- Candidates may represent the school or compete as an independent student not affiliated with the school.
- Classical Ballet candidates of Junior AS, Junior BS, Senior S and Adult S must perform in pointe shoes. ABC recommends candidates practice safe and proper technique when performing in pointe shoes.
- For all classical variations, slight modifications and simplifications of the original arrangement aimed at younger students are permitted.
- If significant changes are made to a classical variation for exaggerating the technical skills, this may result in point deduction or disqualification.
- Contemporary candidates must demonstrate strong contemporary technique with no emphasis on gymnastics skills.
- Candidates are recommended to perform their solo variation in costumes for both Ballet and Contemporary pieces.
- Age is defined by 1st August 2024.
- Professional dancers are not allowed to participate in the ABC competition. A professional dancer is defined as a person who is currently or has been employed as a full-time dancer, including apprentices in professional dance companies.
- Any changes to registration information will incur an administrative fee of HK\$500 and may not be reflected in the competition digital program booklet.
- Registration or registered information updates are only confirmed upon receipt of payment.
- All amounts quoted and paid in HK dollars only.

Rules and Regulations

- All registration and registered information updating administrative fees are non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.
- Anyone who fills in false information in the registration form will be disqualified.
- ABC reserves the right to refuse any registration in its sole discretion.
- Jury members associated with any candidate or school will be exempt from scoring candidates.
- The final score for each candidate is the average score given by ABC Jury members.
- Jury members reserve the right to award any award or scholarship based on the suitability of the candidate. The jury's decision on all awards and scholarships is final and irrevocable.
- All candidates perform at their own risk. Candidates agree that they are of good health and fitness and physically able to participate in the (ABC) Asian Ballet Competition 2024. Asian Grand Prix Limited ("AGP") accepts no responsibility for any bodily injury, illness, death, medical treatment, property damage, accident or loss of property. Whilst all care will be taken, AGP holds harmless from any candidates, and on behalf of themselves, their heirs, any personal representatives any and all causes of action, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses and compensation for damage or loss to themselves and/or property that may be sustained caused by any act, or failure to act of or that may otherwise arise in any way in connection with their attendance at the competition. This liability disclaimer extends to AGP together with all its members, and employees.
- All candidates shall obey any reasonable direction by Organizers. Any candidate failing to comply with this rule shall be liable to disqualification.
